



Unknown Suspect(s) Sought for the Murder of Edgar Luna \$1,000 Reward Offered

January 8, 2011

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and Investigators from the Oceanside Police Department are asking for assistance from the public to identify and locate an unknown suspect(s) wanted for murder.

Investigators said that on Friday, December 3, 2010 at about 8:17 p.m., eighteen-year-old Edgar Luna was shot in an apparent drive-by shooting on the 200 block of Lustrosos in Oceanside.

Edgar Luna was taken to a local hospital for treatment but died of his injuries on December 8, 2010.

There was a Christmas Posada happening in the area at the time of the shooting. It was attended by a large group of adults and children. Police are asking anyone who may have seen the incident to contact the Oceanside Police Department or Crime Stoppers.

Today at 10:00 a.m., at the site of the shooting, at the 200 block of Lustrosos, the family of Edgar Luna and Oceanside PD investigators will be available for interviews.
