



Unknown Suspect Sought for Sexual Battery

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and Investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Child Abuse Unit are asking for assistance from the public in identifying a suspect wanted for sexual battery.

On 09/29/2010, at about 12:45 PM, a 13-year-old female was molested in the 600 block of 32nd Street. The victim was walking north on the east side of 600 32nd Street, between "G" and Market Streets. The suspect was walking south on the same side of the street. As the suspect and the victim passed each other, the suspect grabbed the victim's buttocks. The suspect then continued to walk south to Market Street and went westbound.

Suspect Description: The suspect was described as a Hispanic male, about 30 years of age, heavy set, with a dark complexion. He was wearing a white tank top shirt and khaki shorts.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity and or location of the person responsible for this crime to call the SDPD Child Abuse Unit at (619) 531-2260 or the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
