



Unknown Suspects Sought for Rancho Santa Fe Burglaries; Surveillance Video Available

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego County Sheriff's Department Encinitas Station are asking for assistance from the public in identifying two suspects wanted for two burglaries that occurred in Rancho Santa Fe.

On 10-13-10 at approximately 12:40 p.m., two unknown suspects burglarized two residences in Rancho Santa Fe. The first burglary took place on the **** block of **** Street. The second burglary occurred on the **** block of *** Street. The suspects were interrupted while burglarizing the first/second home by the homeowner. Suspect #1 attacked the homeowner and forcibly took his wallet. The homeowner suffered ***** injuries.

The suspects took mostly jewelry but an **NSA (?) identification card** was also stolen.

The suspects possibly fled the scene in a late 1990's or early 2000's model, silver, 4-door Toyota Camry.

One of the burglaries was captured by pet monitoring cameras that were in one of the residences. A copy of the video can be picked up today at the Sheriff's Department's Headquarters, located at 9621 Ridgehaven Court, San Diego, CA 92193.

****Please note that the camera distorted clothing colors.****

Suspect #1 – Black male adult – late 20's, 5'8"-5'9" tall, 250-300 lbs with a muscular build, wearing a button down long-sleeved dress shirt, dress pants and dress shoes. (what color were his shirt and pants)

Suspect #2 – Black male adult – 6'0"-6'5", large build, tattoo behind the right ear. (No clothing description?)

Suspect Vehicle – possibly a late 1990's or early 2000's model, silver, 4-door Toyota Camry.
