



Unknown Suspect Sought for Annoying a Child

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and Investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Central Division are asking for assistance from the public in identifying a suspect wanted for annoying a child.

On Friday 10/15/2010, at about 3:00 PM, a 10 year old boy (victim) went to Grant Hill Park located at 2600 J Street, to play by himself. He was the only person in the park. The victim noticed an unknown male suspect drive around the park several times before parking. The suspect approached the victim from a distance of about 12'-15' and said, "Come here, I have your birthday gift for you." The victim ran away from the park without any further incident. The victim said the suspect was following him as he ran away but the suspect never ran after the victim.

Suspect Description: Hispanic male, 30-38 years old, chubby build, dark skin, 5'8"-5'9" tall, wore a red baseball cap with "SD" (white or gray) in the front, a black t-shirt with white skulls, black jeans (possibly "skinny" jeans) and black converse or vans shoes

Suspect Vehicle: White older model (approximately 2000) stock Ford Mustang with tinted windows. The vehicle was loud, possibly had a modified exhaust/engine.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity and or location of the person responsible for this crime to call SDPD Central Division detectives at (619) 744-9500 or the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest in this case. Anonymous email and text messages can be sent in via www.sdcrimestoppers.com.
