



Unidentified Suspect Sought in Armed Robbery; Surveillance Video Captures Suspect's Picture

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and detectives from the San Diego County Sheriff's Department Lemon Grove Station are asking for assistance from the public in identifying a suspect wanted for robbing a 7-11 in Lemon Grove.

Detectives said that on October 26, 2010 at about 1:00 A.M., an unknown male suspect entered the 7-11, located at 7607 Broadway in Lemon Grove. He walked to the back of the store, got a can of ice-tea and walked to the register. As the clerk scanned the drink the suspect reached to the right side of his waist band as if he had a gun and demanded money from the clerk. The clerk took an undisclosed amount of money from the cash register and handed it to the suspect. The suspect fled the store on foot and was last seen west bound on Broadway.

The store surveillance video captured the suspect's image.

Robbery Suspect Description: *Black male, between 20-29 years old, approximately 6'1" tall with a muscular build. He was clean shaven and was wearing a black shirt, black pants and a black rag on his head.*

Detectives are asking anyone with information on the identity and or location of the person responsible for this crime to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
