Public's Help Needed to Identify Robbery Suspects

\$1,000 Reward Offered

January 21, 2010

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with San Diego County Sheriff's Department Vista investigators to help identify and apprehend the suspects responsible for a robbery that occurred at a local bakery.

On January 19, 2010, at approximately 11:40 a.m., two suspects robbed Chico's Panaderia, a bakery, located at 1110 N. Santa Fe Avenue in Vista. Suspect #1 entered the store and selected some pastries from the display case. As he was paying for the items he demanded the employee give him money from the cash register. The suspect pulled a black semi-automatic handgun from his waistband and again demanded cash. He then chambered a round in the gun and repeated his demands. The employee held out the money from the register for the suspect to take. At that point Suspect #2 entered the bakery and took the money from the employee. Both suspects fled the store on foot. They were last seen going southbound on N. Santa Fe Avenue.

The cash loss was about \$500.00.

The suspects are described as follows:

Suspect #1 is an Hispanic adult male between 40-50 years old. He was described as being about 5'07" tall with a thin build and mustache. He was wearing a black beanie and a brown jacket.

Suspect #2 is described as an Hispanic adult male between 35-40 years old. He had a heavy build and was wearing a blue shirt and white athletic shoes.

Sketches of both suspects are attached to page 2 of this release.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity of the person(s) responsible for this crime to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest. Anonymous email and text messages can be sent in via www.sdcrimestoppers.com.
