Robbery Suspect Caught on Tape

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

January 29, 2010

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's robbery unit are asking for assistance from the public in identifying a male suspect wanted for robbery.

On January 24, 2010, at approximately 5:40 a.m., an unknown male suspect robbed the 7/11 store at 2285 Palm Avenue in San Diego. The suspect pretended to be a customer and asked for assistance. While the clerk rang up the items to be purchased, the suspect simulated having a weapon by placing his right hand in his jacket pocket and made demands for money. The clerk complied and the suspect left with the merchandise and money. The suspects jacket, baseball cap and the items rang up by the clerk were recovered a short distance from the crime scene. The money was not recovered.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, approximately 30 years of age, about 5'4" tall, thin mustache, gray jacket and blue jean pants.

A surveillance camera captured the suspect on video. A copy of this video can be obtained today until 4:00pm at the SDPD Broadway side front counter.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity and or location of the person responsible for this crime to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest in this case. Anonymous email and text messages can be sent in via www.sdcrimestoppers.com.
