Seriously Injured Woman Found by Sheriff's Deputies; Information Sought

Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

February 11, 2010

San Diego County Crime Stoppers is joining forces with San Diego County Sheriff's Department Vista detectives to find out what happened to a woman who was found seriously injured in a parking lot in the city of Vista.

On February 01, 2010, at about 5:50 P.M., Sheriff's deputies and the Vista Fire Department responded to a call of an injured and unresponsive female at the 99-Cent Store strip mall parking lot, located at 1234 N. Santa Fe Avenue in Vista.

Deputies found a 66-year-old Hispanic female with numerous injuries including serious head trauma. She was unresponsive and was immediately transported to a local hospital where she is currently in the Intensive Care Unit.

Investigators say the injuries were likely caused by the victim either being struck by a car, or from a severe beating. They are asking any witnesses to please come forward to help identify the persons responsible for this crime.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity of the person responsible for this crime to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest. Anonymous email and text messages can be sent in via www.sdcrimestoppers.com.
