



## Unidentified Suspect Sought for Downtown Pedestrian Robbery

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

**San Diego County Crime Stoppers** and Investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Central Division are asking for assistance from the public in identifying a suspect wanted for a Downtown pedestrian robbery.

*Investigators said on February 1<sup>st</sup> 2010 at about 9:30 PM, the suspect contacted the victim in the 700 block of 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue in Downtown San Diego. The victim was walking home from a friend's house. The suspect grabbed the victim by the arm and pulled him into an area offset from the sidewalk. The suspect then punched the victim, knocking him to the ground. The suspect continued to punch and kick the victim several times while he was on the ground, knocking him unconscious and breaking his nose. During the assault, the suspect took cash from the victim's pants pocket.*

*The suspect is described as a black male, 23-25 years old, 6'3"-6'4" tall with a fit build. The suspect was wearing a #11 Arizona Cardinals Jersey, with a Navy blue zip-up hooded sweatshirt on top.*

*A facial composite of the suspect is attached to this release.*

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity and or location of the person responsible for this crime to call SDPD Central Division at (619) 744-9500 or the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to an arrest in this case.
