



March 2008 Murders of Brandon Johnson and Donnell Davis Jr. Remain Unsolved Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers, working with the San Diego County Sheriff's Department's homicide unit, is asking for the public's assistance to help identify and locate the person(s) responsible for the murder of Brandon Johnson and Donnell Davis Jr.

On March 16, 2008 Brandon Johnson and his best friend, Donnell Davis, were shot and killed while riding in a vehicle on Highway 54. Brandon, Donnell and two other friends were heading home from the Brunswick Premier Lanes in Chula Vista when a car pulled alongside and fired multiple gun shots into their car.

Brandon was a very happy, loving young man with a bright smile and big dreams. He touched the lives of many during his short life. He loved basketball, football and video games. Brandon also had a great relationship with his family. He loved his grandmother's home cooked meals and also loved going fishing with his grandfather.

Donnell was a talented athlete who always wanted to "take his game to the next level". He loved football and track and field. To know Donnell was to love him. At school his smile would light up the quad.

The boys met in 6th grade and became life-long friends. They spent so much time together that they convinced their families to move down the street from each other.

On Tuesday, March 16, 2010 at 10:00 a.m., Brandon and Donnell's friends and family will hold a vigil on what is the second anniversary of their deaths. The vigil will be in front of the Brunswick Premier Lanes, located at 845 Lazo Court in Chula Vista.
