



Unidentified Suspect Sought for Vista Bank Robbery

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

March 22, 2010

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and Investigators from the San Diego Sheriff's Department's Vista Station are asking for assistance from the public in identifying a suspect wanted for bank robbery.

Investigators said that on March 18, 2010 at about 2:12 P.M., an unknown black male adult entered the US Bank, located at 640 Hacienda Drive in Vista. The suspect showed one of the bank tellers a demand note and received an unknown amount of cash. After the suspect left the bank he tried to pull an elderly man from his vehicle but was chased away by a Good Samaritan.

The suspect is described as a black male, in his mid-20's, 5'6"- 5'7"' tall. The suspect was wearing a dark baseball cap, dark sweatshirt, blue jeans and a light blue hospital mask

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity and or location of the person responsible for this crime to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
