



Unidentified Suspect Sought for Armed Robbery

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the Chula Vista Police Department are asking for assistance from the public in identifying a suspect wanted for armed robbery.

Investigators said that on January 29, 2010 at about 8:43 P.M., an unknown male robbed the Chevron Gas Station, located at 695 E. Palomar Street in Chula Vista. The suspect entered the convenience store, showed the clerk a silver handgun, and demanded money. The suspect took an undisclosed amount of cash and left in an unknown direction.

The suspect may be linked to several other armed robberies in the Chula Vista area. He is described as a Hispanic male, 25-35 years old, approximately 5'04"-5'06" tall with weighs about 160-180 lbs. The suspect was wearing a black baseball cap, grey sweatshirt, black jeans and white tennis shoes.

Several pictures of the suspect were obtained via surveillance cameras and attached to page two of this news release.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity and or location of the person responsible for this crime to call Crime **Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
