



Unidentified Suspect(s) Sought in Stater Brothers Markets Robbery

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

April 21, 2010

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and Investigators from the San Diego Sheriff's Department's Poway Station are asking for assistance from the public in identifying a suspect(s) wanted for a robbery.

Investigators said that on April 19, 2010 at about 8:54 PM, an unknown suspect entered the Stater Brothers Markets, located at 13589 Poway Road in Poway and forced his way into the pharmacy. He showed the pharmacist a black semi-automatic handgun and demanded Oxycontin and other prescription drugs. The suspect told the pharmacist to put the prescription drugs in a green re-usable shopping bag.

After obtaining the drugs, the suspect left the store through the north doors and was last seen walking eastbound on Poway Road toward Midland Road. No vehicle was seen or heard leaving the area.

The suspect is described as a White male, approximately 20 years old, 5'10" tall with a thin/medium build. He was wearing sunglasses, a black and white checkered hooded sweatshirt and blue jeans.

A few minutes before the armed robbery took place another white male adult entered the market and was acting as if he were casing the area. He entered through the north doors and stood near the entrance before leaving to make a cell phone call. After the phone call he entered the market again, grabbed a 36-pack of Coors beer and walked out without paying. Investigators think that these two incidents may be related. This male is listed as suspect #2 in this release and is a person of interest in the armed robbery.

Suspect #2 is described as a white, male adult, approximately 18-20 years old, 5'10" tall with a medium build. He was wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, a black baseball cap, a black t-shirt with a white logo on it, blue jeans and white tennis shoes

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity and or location of the person(s) responsible for this crime to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
