



Unidentified Suspect Sought For Grand Theft

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and Investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Western Division are asking for assistance from the public in identifying a suspect wanted for grand theft.

Investigators said on 04-01-2010, at approximately 6:45 p.m., an unknown white male suspect entered Ben Bridge Jewelers located at 7007 Friars Road (Fashion Valley Mall.) The suspect asked to see two Rolex watches valued at over \$20,000. The clerk handed both watches to the suspect, the suspect immediately walked out of the store with the watches.

Several pictures of the suspect were obtained via surveillance cameras and attached to page two of this news release.

Suspect #1: *White male, 22-25 years-old, 5'7"-5'9" tall, thin build, brown hair and clean shaven.*

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the identity and or location of the persons responsible for this crime to call SDPD Western Division at (619) 692-4800 or the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
