



Felony Warrant Suspect Sought

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego County Sheriff's Department Lemon Grove Station are asking for assistance from the public in locating a suspect wanted for burglary.

On August 5, 2010, a felony arrest warrant was issued for Gregory Richard Arkwright for burglary. He has been linked to several burglaries in the Rancho San Diego and Spring Valley areas of the County.

Gregory Richard Arkwright is known to frequent the East Count and is a known methamphetamine user. He is described as a 30-year-old White male, 6'2", 140 lbs., with brown hair and brown eyes.

Investigators are asking anyone with information on the location of this suspect to call the **Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477**.
